Grade Five- 3 classes= 75 students (maximum); if only 54 or less enroll by March 16 only two teachers and a waiting list.

Expectations: 58 to 64 students

Grade Six- 2 classes= 54 students (maximum); waiting list after 54 Students.

Expectations: 48 to 52 students

Grade Seven- 3 classes= 75 students (maximum) *

Expectations: 58 to 65 students

Grade Eight- 3 classes= 75 students (maximum) *
