Day Camp

We offer a variety of camps for children ages 3-15. Our goal...to make sure your child goes home happy, tired, and excited to return the next day!

All Camps:

- Camp Hours: 9am-4m
- Before/After Care available 7am-9am and 4pm-6pm
- Prices: YMCA Members: \$120 (Non Members \$135)
- Before or After Camp costs an additional \$5 for members and \$10 for non members
- Before and After Camp costs an additional \$10 for members and \$15 for non members

First Camp (ages 3-5):

- Held at the West Carrollton YMCA
- Part-Time Camp available (less than 25 hours/week)
- Organized Swim Lessons
- Introduction to sports of all sorts
- Focus on school preparation

Kinder Camp (ages 5-6):

- Held at Harry Russell Elementary
- This camp is for children too mature for First Camp, but not mature enough for traditional camp
- Enrichment activities, nature exploration, fitness and nutrition education, and much more
- Organized Swim Lessons and field trips

Traditional Day Camp (ages 7-12):

- Held at Harry Russell Elementary
- Swimming, Field Trips, Nature Exploration, Fitness and Nutrition Education, and Much More!
- Weekly Field Trips

Counselors in Training (CIT) (ages 12-15):

- Held at Harry Russell Elementary
- Our CITs learn how to become leaders and enjoy special field trips and overnights.
- We test CITs during week five. If they pass the CIT training curriculum, they graduate and the second 1/2 of summer is FREE!

Part-time/Specialty Camp (ages 6-15):

- Held at Mark Twain Elementary
- This camp is a flexible camp. It's for children who want to experience camp on a smaller scale
- Children can only attend a maximum of 25 hours/week
