

Godparents

Have your child's godparents been a presence in your child's life?

We ask that at least one baptismal godparent be a part of the First Communion preparation.

Godparent letters are requested for each child from at least one godparent. The letter should include his or her thoughts and memories from your child's baptism, as well as any inspirational notes of encouragement in your child's faith journey. Another part of the letter may include the godparent's own First Communion remembrances.

The godparent should put the letter in an envelope with your child's name written clearly on the front. All godparent letters need to be returned to me by April 21st. They will not be opened or read and will be referenced as part of the offertory for church. The letters will be given to the children in their Sacrament envelopes at the receptions after each First Communion mass. In order to ensure that the letters are received in time for First Communion, please be sure your child's name is clearly on the sealed envelope.

We encourage godparents to be a part of the Banner Day/Bread Baking activity for First Communion candidates.

Note: If other family members would like to join in on writing letters to your child for their Sacrament envelopes, please encourage them to do so. However, other letters cannot be in place of a godparent letter, so please do your best to have the godparents write this letter.
