Amen.

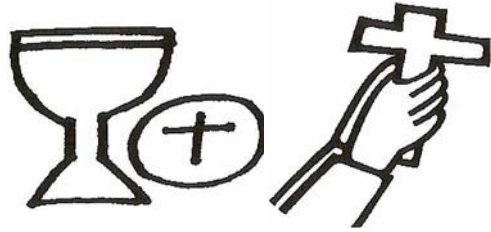

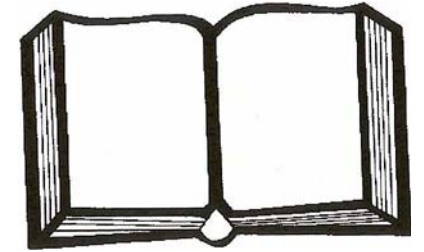
