Come and see for yourself!

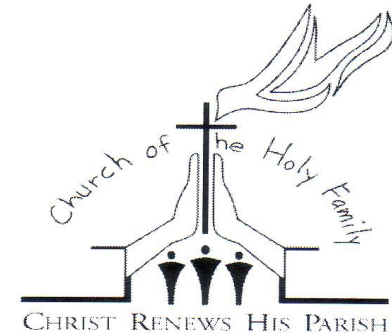

What is “Christ Renews His Parish?”

Christ Renews His Parish (CRHP) is a process designed to bring members of a parish together in Christ. All of our commitments, including our commitment to Christ, need renewal if we are to be faithful. CRHP is an effective spiritual renewal process, which calls together the members of the parish, priests, religious and laity in order to experience conversion and Christian community in the environment of our own parish.

What CRHP is not

It is not a silent retreat.
It is not a parish organization.
It is not a public confession.
It is not an emotional cult.
It is not a parish clique.

Who may attend?

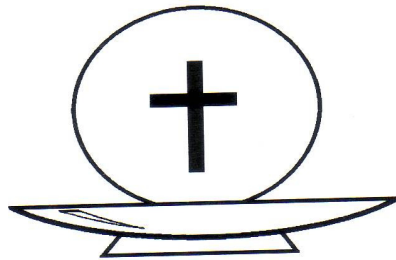
The weekend is open to all parishioners of Holy Family Catholic Church, who are at least 18 years old, and out of high school.

Who facilitates the weekend?

The weekend is given by parishioners, for parishioners. A team that has attended a previous CRHP weekend has worked in prayerful preparation to Present this weekend retreat.

What happens on a weekend?

Come prepared to have fun, and to renew your heart. The process is centered around reflections by team members with some small group discussions and activities. Topics covered include ‘Our Father’s loving care for us,’ ‘Scripture,’ ‘Eucharist,’ and ‘What Christian life is all about.’



Celebrations of the Sacraments are part of the weekend. Mass is celebrated on Sunday morning.

Reconciliation is offered with the parish priests and/or visiting priests from other neighboring parishes.

When and where are the weekends held?

The weekends are held in our parish church & facilities from Saturday morning until Sunday afternoon. There will be one men’s and one women’s retreat weekend each spring and fall.
