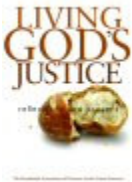


Prayer Resources

Our Prayers Rise Like Incense: Liturgies for Peace

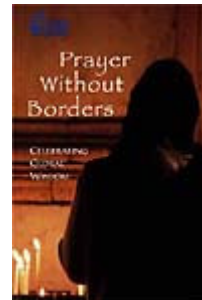
