



NCCW/CRS Partnership Programs

CRS is obligated by law to accept donations only for programs that they manage themselves or in collaboration with other humanitarian organizations. Consequently, we must ask you to designate your monies only to the **recognized** and **current** operational programs sponsored on behalf of NCCW for the benefit of women and children and listed on this page. To assist you in choosing the program(s) to which you wish to donate, we are including a brief description of each.

WORKS OF PEACE

- **Madonna Plan:** Projects meet the health, nutritional and educational needs of women, and offers microfinance aid to help women start small businesses to generate income for themselves and their families.
- **Water for Life:** These programs provide communities with resources to build water systems that can deliver clean water to them, creating jobs and developing skills in water sanitation.

WORKS OF RECONCILIATION

- **Refugee Women Emergency Fund:** This fund helps meet the vast need for relief and compassion to women in emergencies - refugees, displaced persons, and victims of natural disaster. This program was established to ensure that those most vulnerable - women and their children - have access to gender-specific resources over and above what

is provided during emergency efforts. These include adequate food, water, medicines, shelter, safety and leadership training.

HELP-A-CHILD

- **Help-A-Child Africa, India or Latin America:** Programs help meet the health, nutrition, and educational needs of children. Donations can be sent monthly or as a one-time donation.
- **Help-A-Child Global Fund:** HAC Global assists vulnerable children around the world, wherever the need is greatest, by providing nutritious meals, sustaining education, implementing local health care and establishing youth centers that address local issues. All monies received at NCCW for Help-A-Child that are not designated for Africa, India or Latin America go to the Global fund.

NCCW Remembrance Cards: These cards, available from the national office, can be used to make donations to any of the NCCW/CRS programs in someone's honor or memory.
