How to Submit Donations for Works of Peace and Works of Reconciliation

Please make sure all donations to NCCW/CRS include:

- ◆ Identification of the specific, current program (listed below)
- ◆ Your organization or personal donor number (if known)
- ◆ Your check payable to NCCW

This will greatly assist record-keeping and accuracy.

CRS is obligated by law to accept only donations for programs that they manage themselves or in a plan of collaboration with other humanitarian organizations. We must ask you to designate your monies to the **recognized** and **current** operational programs sponsored on behalf of NCCW for the benefit of women and children and listed on this page. To assist you determine the appropriate designation for your donation, we are including a brief description of each.

WORKS OF PEACE

- **Madonna Plan:** Projects meet the health, nutritional and educational needs of women as well as funding development projects which help women improve their economic security and, therefore, improve the life of their family.
- **Water for Life:** All projects work to bring water to communities. There are no designated countries.

HELP-A-CHILD

- **Help-A-Child Africa, India or Latin America:** Programs help meet the health, nutrition, and educational needs of children. Donations can be sent monthly or as a one-time donation.
- **Help-A-Child Global Fund:** A new designation to fund projects to assist children any place in the world. It allows NCCW to support emergency or long-term projects for children where CRS is called upon for help. All monies received at NCCW for Help-A-Child that are not designated for Africa, India or Latin America will be used in this manner. You will receive a report on this fund in each CRS Annual Report.

- **Refugee Women Emergency Fund:** This fund assists CRS to provide gender-sensitive services for women who are displaced in their own country or refugees in other countries.

The partnership with CRS is a long and valuable one, and the lives of women and children with the greatest need have been made better by your generosity and the diligent commitment of CRS. You will continue to receive updates on all NCCW- sponsored programs in *Catholic Woman* and the *CRS Annual Report*.
