

Confirmation Preparation

Purpose/Mission: This instruction is to prepare those that are to receive one of the three “sacraments of Christian initiation.” The reception of the sacrament of Confirmation is necessary for the completion of baptismal grace. For “by the sacrament of Confirmation, the baptized are more perfectly bound to the Church and are enriched with a special strength of the Holy Spirit. Hence they are, as true witnesses of Christ, more strictly obliged to spread and defend the faith by word and deed.”

Services Provided:

- * Instruction for Confirmation preparation is provided to youth through the Religious Education program of the parish.
- * Arranges with the priest, the bishop, and the recipients, parents, and sponsors, the schedule and the facility for receipt of the sacrament.
- * Offers guidance to the recipients in the selection of appropriate sponsors.
- * Arranges for Confirmation preparation for adults.
