Purpose/Mission: To develop a deepening awareness of the need to create and maintain a climate of hospitality within our Eucharistic assemblies and to provide a very special service in their exercise of a true liturgical ministry.

Services Provided: Ushers representing the parish community are called upon to function as hosts and hostesses while providing the following services:

- * Arranging all things necessary prior to mass and greeting all those arriving for church services.
- * Maintain a special level of awareness and assistance to new parish members, visitors, the aged, or any that may require special attention.
- * Invite newcomers to meet other parish members, and help them feel at home.
- * Assist in taking the offertory collection.
- * Coordinate the communion procession.
- * After each service, open the church doors, distribute bulletins to parish members, and retrieve such items as mass books and Hymnals.
- * Ensure that the church is clean after each service and that Mass books and hymnals are placed properly in the pews.
- * Adjust the windows, air conditioning, or heating.
- * Secure items that may have been left behind, and see that the church is in order for the next service.
