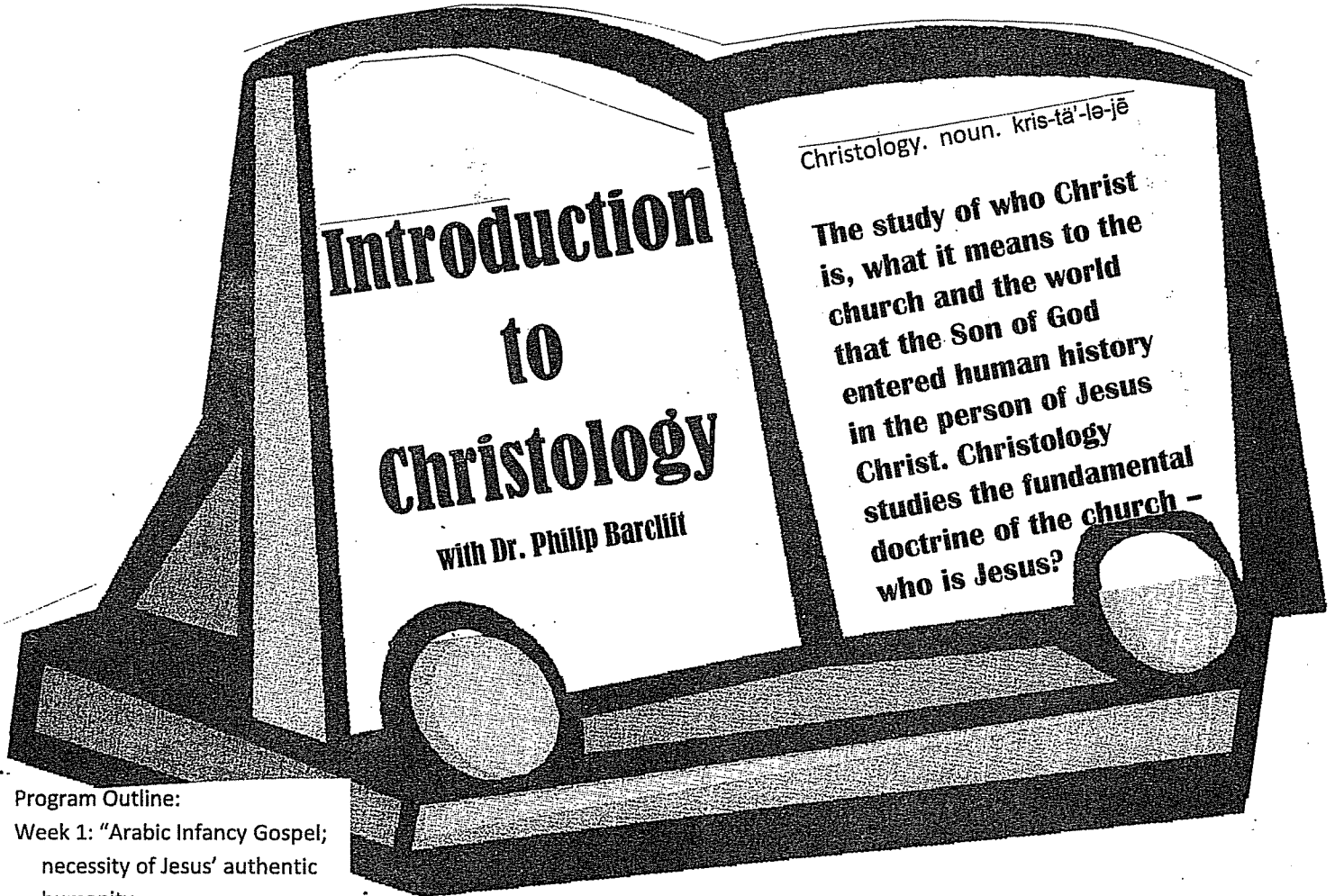


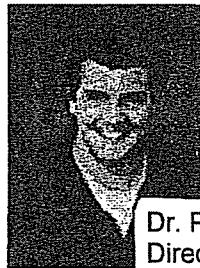

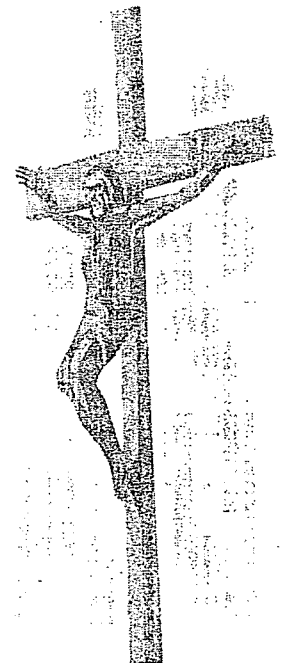


**Program Outline:**
