

ST. MARY'S SCHOOL DRESS CODE

****All Junior High khaki clothing and girls skirts, pants and shorts must be purchased from Schoolbelles or Lands' End. Plaid skirts are only available from Schoolbelles.**

BLOUSES/SHIRTS

Color: Light blue, white, or navy. **Style:** Must have collar. Long, 3/4 or short sleeve: oxford blouse, polo shirt, or turtleneck. All of the above **must be tucked in**. Shirts may be ordered with school logo from Schoolbelles or Lands' End.

Junior High: Color: Yellow (maize), white, gray, or black **Style:** Same

PANTS/SLACKS

Color: Navy blue. **Style:** DRESS pant. Corduroy or cotton twill, elastic waist or belted.

Junior High: Color: Black, gray, or khaki **Style:** Same

BELTS

Color: Solid black. Must be worn with pants that have belt loops, not necessary on elastic waist pant. Belt loops should not be removed from pants.

SHORTS/SKORTS

Color: Solid navy blue. **Style:** KNEE LENGTH, walking shorts, no cargo shorts. Shorts/skorts may be worn before December 1st and after March 31st. May not be worn on mass days.

Junior High: Color: Black, gray, or khaki **Style:** Same

SWEATERS

Color: Solid navy blue, white, or light blue. **Style:** Cardigan, vest, pullover v-neck or pullover crew neck to be worn over uniform shirt/blouse. **No hooded tops.** St. Mary's non hooded sweatshirts and fleece with logo may be worn January to the end of March except on mass days.

Junior High: Color: White, black, yellow (maize), or gray **Style:** Same

SKIRTS/JUMPERS

Color: Solid navy or St. Mary's uniform plaid from Schoolbelles. Color #1376. **Style:** KNEE LENGTH. **MUST BE WORN ON MASS DAYS WITH UNIFORM BLOUSE.**

Junior High: Color: Black, gray, khaki or Schoolbelles uniform plaid #933 **Acceptable Style:** Lands' End p. 22 c,d,e,f

SOCKS/TIGHTS

Color: Solid navy or white. Crew or knee socks must be worn at all times.

Junior High: Color: Black, gray, or white. Girls may wear nylons.

SHOES

Dress shoes in black, brown, or navy are encouraged. White, navy, or black tennis shoes may be worn. Shoes must be tied, on the outside, or have velcro. Students must wear regulation gym shoes for gym class. **Unacceptable:** Heels higher than one inch (excluding platform), sling backs, open toes, backless, sandals, clogs, crocs, or roller shoes.

TIES:

Color: Solid navy blue ties must be worn on Mass Days.

Junior High: Color: Black or gray, solid or patterned .

MAKEUP / JEWELRY

Light or clear nail polish only. Girls may wear only stud style earrings. NO earrings for boys. No choker style necklaces, simple chain style only. No excessive accessories: bracelets, necklaces, etc.

***Junior High:** Light colored lip gloss is acceptable.*

HAIR

Must be clean, neat, and with no coloring. No longer than top of the collar on boys. All hair must be above the eyebrow and not hang over the face. Unacceptable: Fad styles that draw unnecessary attention or are a distraction to the individual.

***Junior High:** Light blond highlighting or frosting is acceptable.*

MASS DAYS

Boys must wear uniform ties with a dress shirt. Girls must wear uniform skirts or jumpers with a uniform blouse. Girls may wear uniform dress slacks for Mass from December 1st until March 31st due to cold weather. Unacceptable: shorts, skorts, split skirts and turtlenecks.

SPIRIT DAYS (FRIDAY'S)

Students may wear St. Mary's t-shirts, sweatshirts, sweatpants, and St. Mary's fleece. With these tops they may also wear solid color black or gray sweatpants or windpants without side snaps. Windpants may have white, yellow, gold or grey side stripes. No sweat shorts. Students may wear uniforms.

SPORTS TEAMS AND SCOUTS

Students who participate in CYO grade school sports may wear their uniform shirts on the day of a game. When the game is on a no school day, shirts may be worn the day before. They must be worn over the required St. Mary's School uniform shirt. Shirts should be worn with uniform pants. Scouts may wear their uniforms on meeting days.

FIELD TRIPS

Usual school attire unless directed by teacher.

NON UNIFORM DAYS

All clothing, including jeans, must be neat, clean, pressed if needed, and free of tears and holes. NO tank tops, bare midriffs, low cut, form fitting, oversized, or inappropriate attire. T- shirts must have appropriate pictures or slogans.

OUTDOOR WINTER CLOTHING

All students have outdoor recess most days and students should be dressed adequately for outdoor play. In winter warm jackets, hats, gloves, etc. are strongly encouraged. If there is snow on the ground, students need boots. Outdoor clothing may not be worn indoors.

CONSEQUENCES OF VIOLATION OF DRESS CODE

For the first dress code infraction the student will be issued a Dress Code Violation form. For the second infraction students will call their parent for appropriate clothing. Continuing violations will result in a detention or non admittance to class.
