


[STEP ONE]


Go to <http://twitter.com>. You will see the screen below, click the green "Sign up now" button. (Details: this is where you'll come to log in next time, so remember your chosen "user name" and password.)

[STEP TWO]

Select a username (it will tell you immediately if it's available), password, valid email address for updates to be sent to (I suggest a primary email), enter the verification words and permit or deny Twitter to email you news. Click Create my account. (*Details: I suggest using a short, memorable username with your name in it unless you have a nickname that you're willing to allow clients to see. I suggest your primary email as the signup because you may need your Twitter messages from other users to go there.*)

Enter your mobile number with area code, check the box agreeing to receive text messages and click Save. The next screen will prompt you to send a test message to 40404. After your number has been verified, you will receive a confirmation text message from Twitter.




Click Device updates OFF (It will change to ON). This will enable you to receive text message updates from BLS.
