**SPEAK LORD:** today gives the classic text of the spiritual life 'Speak Lord, your servant is listening' How should we be before God? We should have a listening heart, a quiet and open mind. Then we shall hear, as Samuel and Eli did in the temple, as the disciples of Jesus did, when they accepted his invitation to 'come and see'. Jesus is here with us in this Eucharist; let us ask him to show where he lives, who he is, and what he calls us to.

Today, on **PEACE SUNDAY**, he especially calls us to be "Peace People", givers and receivers of peace, peace-makers. Today, please join the priest and say together the Prayer for Peace just before we exchange the Sign of peace with one another

**ORDINARY TIME:** is that 'Liturgical period when no particular aspect of the mystery of Christ is celebrated, but rather the mystery of Christ in all its fullness is recalled.' The colour is green, unless some particular feast is being celebrated, when the colour may be white or red. Today is the second Sunday of Year B. During the week, the readings are from Year 2.

CATHOLIC PARLIAMENTARY AND PUBLIC POLICY INTERNSHIPS

For the last nine years the Catholics Bishops Conference has organised Parliamentary and Public Policy Internships for recently graduated Catholics. This year we are looking to offer 8 internships: Five interns will be placed with Christian MPs at Westminster; two in Public Policy with CAFOD and CARITAS Social Action Network; and one in a media internship at Archbishop's House Westminster.

All internships will run from September 2012 - July 2013 and include accommodation and subsistence allowances.
