“Physician-Assisted Suicide: A Bad Idea for both Doctors and Patients.”

Wm. David Solomon, Ph.D., Director, Center for Ethics at University of Notre Dame

A lecture that looks at the arguments recently given for the legalizing physician-assisted suicide. We will examine why so many people have become convinced that physician-assisted suicide increases patient autonomy and self-determination. We will also look at those considerations traditionally brought against allowing physicians to assist actively in ending the lives of their patients. The argument will be made that there are overwhelming moral, political, and medical reasons for continuing to prohibit physician-assisted suicide.

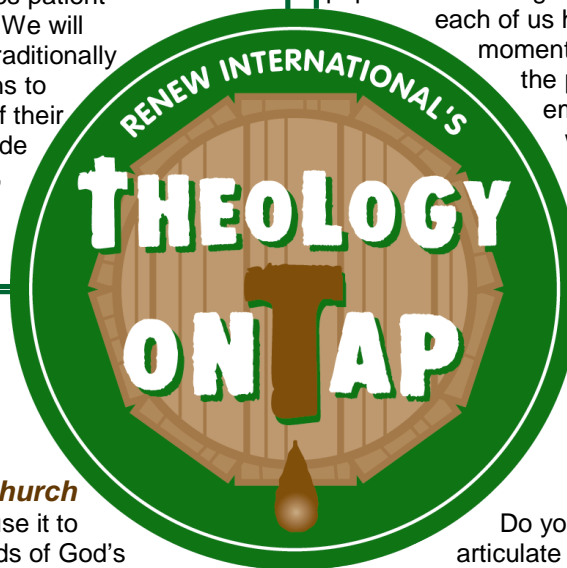
