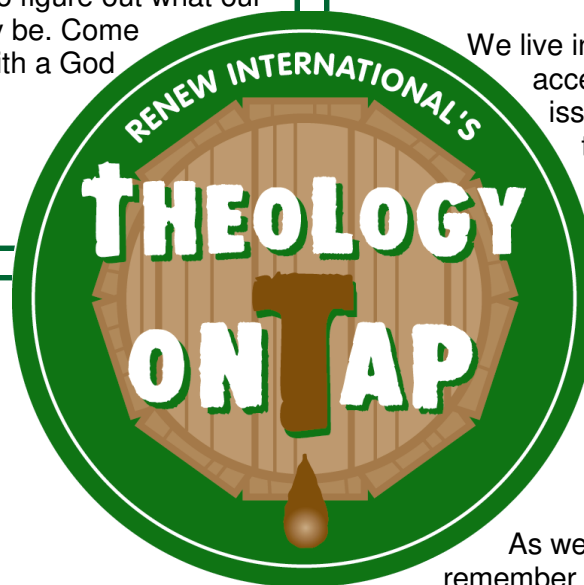
Meet the man, legend, and Saint behind the shamrock. Why we have greater reason to love celebrating this popular Catholic Feast Day.
