

Holy Land & Jordan Tour

November 4: Departure from Cleveland and transfer for overnight transatlantic flight.

November 5: Arrival

Arrive at Amman airport where you will be met by our local guide who will help you clear Immigration and Customs. You are then transferred to the hotel in Amman for dinner and overnight at Le Meridien Amman Hotel. (starwoodhotels.com/lemeridien/property/overview/index.html?propertyID=1878)

November 6: Mt. Nebo, Baptismal site, Allenby, Jericho

Leave Amman and drive on to Mount Nebo where Moses viewed the Promised Land. You can see the Jordan Valley, Jericho and the Judean hills beyond. Also see the remains of Byzantine church with their mosaic floors. Have mass. Proceed to visit the Bethany Beyond the Jordan and visit the Baptismal site. Cross Allenby Bridge into Israel where you will meet the driver and guide for your transfer to Jericho. Visit the excavation of the oldest city in the world. Dinner and overnight in Jericho at the Inter Continental Jericho. (ichotelsgroup.com/intercontinental/en/gb/locations/jrcha?cm_mmc=CJ_-2196845_-2670421_-99613032_Product_Catalog_)

November 7: Mt. Tabor, Bet Shean

This morning we go to the top of Mt. Tabor to enjoy the lovely view and to visit the Church of the Transfiguration for Mass. Continue to Bet Shean, the Decapolis city known as Scythopolis, and see impressive excavations of the Roman city. Drive on to Tiberias for overnight at the Galei Kinnereth Hotel. (rimonim.com/_english/galeikinnereth/index.html)

November 8: The ministry of Christ in the Galilee: Boatripe, Capernaum, Beatitudes, Tabgha, Tiberias

Take the boat across the Sea of Galilee. Stop at Capernaum and see the synagogue and St. Peter's house. Drive to the Mt. of Beatitudes where the Sermon on the Mount was given; then to Tabgha to see the mosaic of the Loaves and Fishes, and the nearby Church of Peter's Primacy where Peter was told, "Feed my lambs," "Feed my sheep." Celebrate Mass on the shores of the Sea of Galilee. If time allows, we visit Baniyas also known as Caesarea Phillippi where Peter said, "Thou are Christ." Overnight in Tiberias.

November 9: Cana, Nazareth, Caesarea, Jerusalem

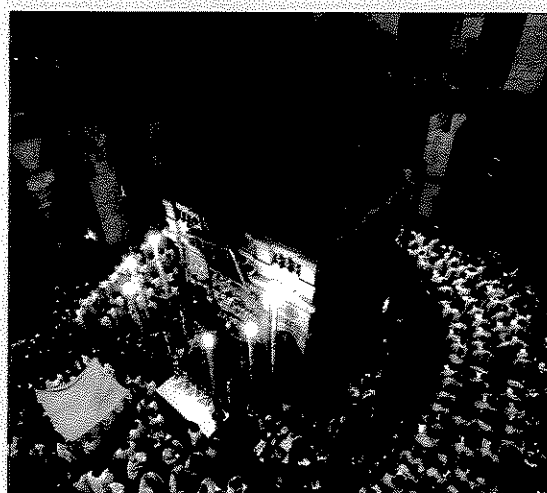
Leave Tiberias and drive to Cana, the village of Jesus' first miracle. For those who wish, you can renew your wedding vows here. Then continue to Nazareth, the boyhood town of Jesus, to visit Mary's well and for Mass at the Basilica of Annunciation. Continue to Haifa and visit the Stella Maris Monastery. From Mount Carmel have a wonderful view of the city, port, River Kishon and the Mediterranean. Stop at Caesarea, once capital of the Roman province, and see Roman and Crusader remains and the harbor from which St. Paul was taken prisoner to Rome. Overnight in Jerusalem at the Inbal Jerusalem Hotel. (www.inbalhotel.com/)

November 10: Bethlehem, St. Anne's, Pool of Bethesda, Temple Mount - Holy Hour

Start the day with a visit to Bethlehem to see the Church of Nativity. Celebrate Mass there. Then to the Shepherds' Field. Return to the Old City of Jerusalem to visit St. Anne's Church which commemorates the site of Mary's birth and the Pool of Bethesda, scene of Jesus' healing miracle. View the Temple Mount and the Dome of the Rock, and then to the Western Wall and the Jewish Quarter. In the evening, at 8 PM go to the Garden of Gethsemane for Holy Hour. A time of reflection and prayer remembering Christ's Agony on his final night.

November 11: Jesus' last hours.

Early morning, walk the Via Dolorosa through the markets of the Old City, with time to meditate and pray the Stations of the Cross. Finally arrive at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre for Mass. After breakfast, drive to the Mount of Olives for a wonderful view of Jerusalem, walk down the hill to Dominus Flevit, where Christ wept over Jerusalem. At the foot of the hill see the Garden of Gethsemane with its ancient olive trees. Drive through the Kidron Valley and see St. Peter in Gallicantu built over the palace of the High Priest Caiaphas. From His prison here, Jesus was

taken to Judgement Hall. He was led through the city to be crucified. Also visit Mt. Zion to see the Upper Room, scene of the Last Supper.

November 12: Ein Karem - Emmaus

Drive through the new part of the city, passing the Knesset and the Hebrew University. Stop at the village of Ein Karem, birthplace of John the Baptist, and visit the Church of St. John. Celebrate Mass. Leave Jerusalem for a short trip to Emmaus; site of the meeting of the two disciples with Jesus after the Resurrection. They invited him to join them in their simple meal and recognized him only when He blessed the bread. Drive back to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.

November 13: Bethany - Qumran - Dead Sea

Drive through the Wilderness of Judea Qumran where the Essene enclave was and see the caves where the Dead Sea Scrolls were hidden. Take a dip in the bitter waters of the Dead Sea. Drive to Bethany, home of Martha, Mary and Lazarus. Mass. Return to Jerusalem.

November 14: Transfer to the airport for departure.

Optional Istanbul Extension, \$1,295

(Historically known as Constantinople)

November 14: Arrive at Istanbul Ataturk Airport. Meet with your guide and drive to the Old City by following the Theodosius City Walls; arrive at Kariye. Visit the Chora Museum-Church of St. Saviour in Chora. See the well preserved frescoes and mosaics depicting scenes from the Bible. Then take a panoramic tour and check in to your hotel. Dinner at your hotel.

November 15: In the morning depart from the hotel and visit the Spice Bazaar near the Galata Bridge, just by the entrance of Golden Horn. Then embark on a ferry for a memorable cruise along the straits of Bosphorus; see many fascinating pavilions, palaces and classical wooden Turkish houses by the water. In the afternoon visit the Hippodrome and the Turkish & Islamic Arts Museum, which was also awarded as one of the best museums of Europe. The building was the palace of a famous Ottoman vizier Ibrahim Pasha. Dinner at a local restaurant.

November 16: In the morning depart from the hotel for a full day of sightseeing. First a visit to the 17th century Blue Mosque, so called due to its more than 20,000 blue Iznik tiles that adorn the interior walls. After, proceed to see the Basilica Underground Cistern, a mystic atmosphere carried by 336 columns. Then to St. Sophia, which was Christendom's greatest church, built by the emperor Justinian, a masterpiece of Byzantine architecture. Then get ready to discover the Topkapı Palace, the residence of the Ottoman Sultans from 15th to 19th centuries. At the end of the tour visit the world famous Grand Bazaar area and then return to your hotel. Dinner will be on your own tonight.

November 17: Transfer to the international airport for your departure flight.

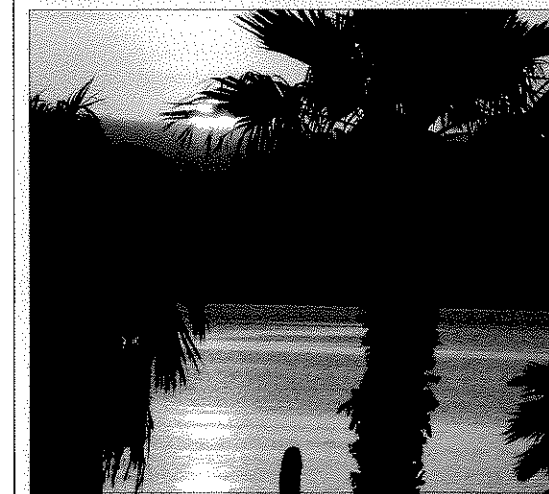

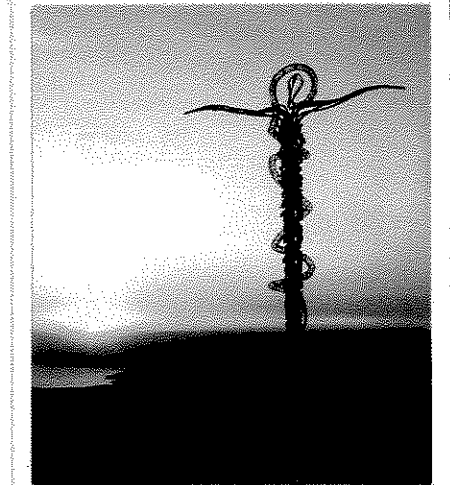
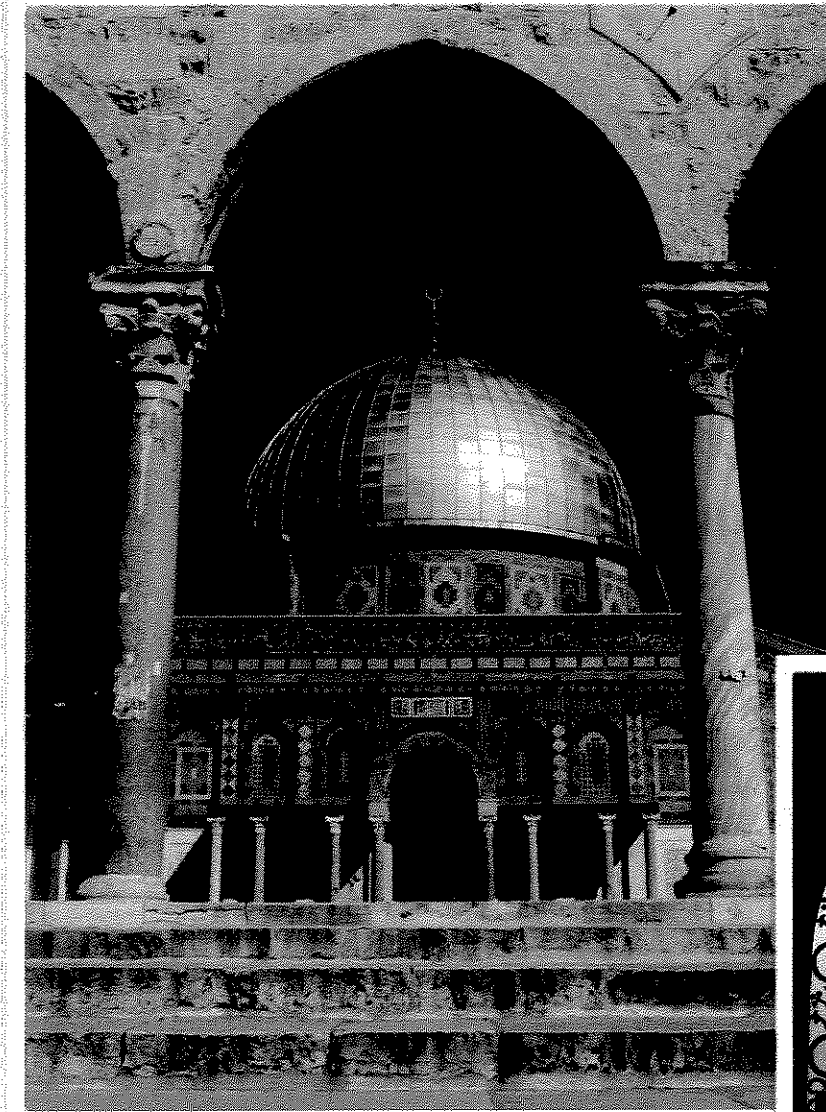
