NOTICE OF STREET CLOSURES FOR FRESNO

The annual Eye-Q Two Cities Marathon and Half returns to Fresno on Sunday, November 8, 2009. This premier event brings thousands of visitors from around the country into Fresno County and is a showcase for our local communities. This year's course is designed to minimize impacts on local residents and businesses, while providing a scenic course and memorable experience for race participants.

This year's loop course starts in Fresno and runs through beautiful neighborhoods lined with brilliant autumn foliage. The Marathon course will also run through historic "Old Town" Clovis, and ends in Fresno's 300 acre Woodward Park. The Marathon features the nation's finest marathon breakfast, lively music, free massages and a beer-garden for those old enough to enjoy!

The Two Cities Marathon Committee has worked closely with the City of Fresno to design a street closure schedule to reduce the inconvenience to those living or doing business along the event route.

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| 1. Friant Road (Audubon to Willow) | Closed 5:00 am – 2:00 pm |
| 2. Teague at Willow intersection | Closed 6:00 am – 11:00 am |
| 3. Shepherd Ave (Friant to Willow - eastbound) | Closed 6:00 am – 8:30 am |
| 4. Shepherd Ave (Friant to Willow - westbound) | Closed 6:00 am – 11:30 am |
| 5. Cedar at Shepherd intersection | Closed 6:00 am – 11:30 am |
| 6. Maple at Shepherd intersection | Closed 6:00 am – 11:30 am |
| 7. Chestnut at Shepherd intersection | Closed 6:00 am – 11:30 am |
| 8. Audubon (Friant to N. Del Mar - westbound) | Closed 5:00 am – 2:00 pm |

Street closures are shown on the map provided on the reverse side of this notice. Please keep this on hand as a reference on the day of the event. Willow Avenue will remain open at all times during the event and is the main north and southbound route. See attached map to locate other alternate routes.
