**BYZANTINE RETREAT:** A Byzantine retreat, "Living Icons of God" is scheduled for Aug. 15, 3 p.m.-Aug. 17, 1 p.m. at the Mount Carmel Spiritual Centre, 7021 Stanley Avenue, Niagara Falls, Ontario, Canada.

Bishop Nicholas Samra will lead the retreat and will present conferences touching on the Eastern Christian spirituality of image and likeness – how each Christian is an icon of God. Each person – man and woman – when fully alive is the glory of God. Accepting this major incarnational theology, Bishop Nicholas will apply it to our life and focus on how we live God's life within and extend it beyond ourselves as we serve the Lord.
