

CHASTITY DAYS

The Chastity Days Program is a joint venture between the Archdiocese of Miami Council of Catholic Women and the Respect Life Ministry.

This year, approximately 2,000 eighth Grade students will attend a special half-day program focusing on various issues, concerns and problems that they may face upon entering high school.

Topics include:

- Definition of Chastity
- Definition of Love vs Infatuation
- Peer Group Pressure
- Effects of Music and Advertising upon student attitudes and behavior
- Information on various sexual diseases and the long term health consequences
- Understanding of life stages from conception to birth, early childhood, teenage years, adult years, middle age and elderly years.

Councils members volunteer to greet the buses, welcome students and Teachers, escort all into each site and view the program. In addition, individual Counsels in the Archdiocese of Miami donate funds to help defray the expenses for Chastity Days.

Respect Life Office plans, prepares, implements the actual program, and prepares the budget.
