Take a Step to Total Stewardship of Treasure ...

1. Find your gross household income in the chart below. Move across on the same line to find the amount you currently give weekly**. Move straight up the column to determine your percentage of giving.
2. Please consider committing at the next level to the right. For example, if your Total Stewardship of Treasure is 2%, consider committing 4%. If your Total Stewardship of Treasure is less than 2%, consider raising your commitment to 2%.
3. Consider setting you eventual goal at 8-10% or more to the Parish Sunday collection and an additional 2% or more to Church and secular charities. It may take a few years to get there, but it can be done by taking just one step at a time.
