



CAMPAIGN UPDATE

December 9, 2011

Since January of 2011, many parish households have either committed to or have been invited to participate in the “Faith in Our Future” Campaign. This has been done through one-on-one visits, small group receptions in a parishioner’s home or at the parish.

Whether you receive an invitation to participate through a one-on-one visit, a small group or parish reception, or through campaign information distributed at church, please accept this call with an open heart. As you already know, this campaign is focused on three commitments: a commitment to pray, a commitment to serve, and a commitment of treasure. With the Holy Spirit guiding us, we will build strong relationships among us in this parish to serve our Lord. Please make a sacrifice of your time to respond positively to an invitation to commit to the campaign. Our goal is to have at least 60% of parish households involved in all or some of these commitments.

So far, 23% of parish households have committed to the campaign.

Also, you will find a short article, “Campaign Snapshot,” in the Bulletin each week on some of the most frequently asked questions about the campaign. Please read this article and look forward to more “snapshots” of what “Faith in Our Future” is focusing on for this parish.

As of December 9, 2011, we have the following campaign commitments:

- 23% participation of registered parish households
- 479 total commitments of Prayer, Service and Treasure
- Treasure commitments totaling \$1,454,918 or 58% of the campaign goal of \$2.5 million
