This International Pilgrim Virgin Statue was blessed by the Bishop of Fatima in 1947 and has been travelling the world since.

The Holy Father, Pope Pius XII, during his famous radio address to the pilgrims at Fatima, May 13, 1951, said, "In 1946 we crowned Our Lady of Fatima as Queen of the World and the next year, through her pilgrim image, she set forth as though to claim Her dominion, and the miracles she performs along the

way are such that we can scarcely believe our eyes at what we are seeing."

This statue has also been known to have shed tears on different occasions – known as the Miracle of Tears.
