

First Communion Quilt Square

It has been a long-standing Mary Queen tradition for the First Communion students to create a quilt. The quilt is a symbol of how we, as God's children, are all unique, and are all connected. This quilt will be on display in the gathering area for the weeks prior to First Communion.

Please keep your design within the dotted lines.

Place the child's name somewhere on the front OR back of the square so it may be returned. Many families choose to frame the square and place it on display in their home.

Symbol Ideas: Host and Chalice, Altar, Bread, Wheat, Grapes, Dove, Cross, Angel, Candle, Fish, Lamb, Heart.

Any materials, markers or paint may be used. If you choose heavy items, such as felt, jewels and/or hot glue, the square may need to be reinforced with an additional hole and tie along the boarder.
