- On Saturday, July 18<sup>th</sup>, Fr. Thomas (Derek) VanDanniker will celebrate a Mass of thanksgiving at the 4:00pm Mass.
  - Arts & Environment should order nice flowers for the occasion.
- Saturday, August 15<sup>th</sup> is the Solemnity of the Assumption. Because this holy day falls on a Saturday this year, obligation is dispensed. The usual 8:15am Mass will be offered.
  - The statue of Mary in the clouds should be moved to the front of the sanctuary for the occasion.
- Wednesday, October 7<sup>th</sup>: Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary.
  - 40 hours starts Monday October 5<sup>th</sup> after the 6:15pm Mass. Adoration will run through Wednesday, ending with the 6:15pm Benediction, Mass, and a party to follow.
  - TBD: whether to hold the normal Thursday adoration.
- All Saints Day: Sunday, November 1<sup>st</sup>.
  - All Souls Day: Monday, November 2<sup>nd</sup>. The traditional 3 Masses for the day will be offered.
- Feast of Christ the King: Sunday, November 22<sup>nd</sup>.
  - Sacrament of Confirmation: Saturday, November 21<sup>st</sup> at the 4:00pm Mass.
- Sunday, November 29<sup>th</sup>: First Sunday of Advent
- Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception: Tuesday, December 8<sup>th</sup>
- Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe: Saturday, December 12<sup>th</sup>.
