NCCW Treasurer Report - Two (2) reports to the Board of Directors and one (1) in the annual business meeting.

Reported that the turnaround plan is starting to work. We are beginning to see the signs but in order to pay off our debt we need the support from women across the United States and that means all of us.

We need to become individual members, and existing individual members need to renew. The Salt Lake City DCCW has ten (10) supporting members, and we thank them. Our most recent reports indicate that we have seventy (70) individual members and we do appreciate all of them, but that is a decrease of thirteen (13) members in just the last five (5) months.

Also, the affiliate dues notices for 2012 have gone out and are due by 12-31-11. Please remind your affiliate presidents to make sure their dues are paid.

Why should we promote membership? Have you looked at the NCCW.org website lately? It is full of four (4) pages of good information and materials for you use.

Campaign for Human Dignity is a free download and it is full of ideas for programs you can do in your parishes.

Under the membership category, there is a power point presentation on how to promote membership for your use.

Under programs is a complete list of activities for your commission chairs to review.

There are a few more new ways to support NCCW.

100 Birthday Club - NCCW turns 100 in 2020. For those that contribute \$100 a year to the birthday club for the next ten years there will be special recognition at the 100 birthday celebration.

Legacy Circle is for those that pledge to give \$1000 a year for the next ten years and they too will receive special recognition.

Finally, the easiest of them all. The NCCW Chase Platimun Visa Card. For everyone who gets a card, NCCW receives \$50 initially and a percentage of your purchases quarterly. There is no annual fee and the interest rate is low.

We need the support of all the women in the Salt Lake City DCCW. We have always been there in the past and we need to continue to be there in the future.
