The Kenny Dolan Living the Faith Scholarship

The St. Ann Serving the Church Scholarship

St. Ann Catholic Church is proud to sponsor the Kenny Dolan Memorial Scholarship. This \$2,500 scholarship is given annually in loving memory of a young man who personified Christianity in its fullest form by his example and by living and sharing his faith through his service to the community.

In addition, each year's recipient will have his or her name engraved on the commemorative plaque that is displayed at St. Ann Church.

The same requirements will also be used to determine the winners of two additional \$1,000 scholarships, the Kenny Dolan Living the Faith and the St. Ann Serving the Church scholarships.

Requirements

In keeping with Kenny's personality and commitment to living as Christ lived, the scholarship is awarded annually to the student who most exemplifies the values of our faith: approaching others with dignity and respect; believing in the self-worth of all people; advocating the Catholic faith; and leading by example, thus being a role model for peers.

The most important factor in granting this scholarship is not academic excellence, but the example of living out his/her Christian values and beliefs, providing an example for his/her fellow students and service to the parish.

Any senior in high school, pursuing post-secondary education, who is registered as a member of St. Ann Catholic Church is eligible to apply for the scholarship.

Application Process

An application is included in this brochure. The deadline for return of applications to the St. Ann Catholic Church parish office is March 1. The recipient will be announced and the award will be given at Senior Recognition in the spring.

Selection Committee

All applications returned by March 1 will be reviewed and the recipient of the scholarship will be selected by a committee composed of the following*:

Pastor, Mike and Dianne Dolan, Associate Pastor for Youth Ministry, Director of Youth Ministry, Knights of Columbus Council 7170 Church Director, Chair of the Pastoral Council, Principal of St. Ann School, Representatives to be appointed by the Pastor.

**If a son, daughter, cousin, niece or nephew of a member of the selection committee should apply, that committee member will be asked to step aside during the selection process.*
