

St. Joseph Students Achieve High Honors

St. Joseph Catholic School in Erie has an honors system in which students in fourth through eighth grades can earn first, second, or third honors. The system is based not only on the students' grades but their conduct and effort as well.

In order to earn first honors, a student must receive all A's in the content subjects and a Satisfactory in conduct and effort. Second honors goes to students who have received all A's and B's in all subject areas. A student must not get below a C in any subject to be awarded third honors. Thirty-nine percent of eligible students in the school earned first honors in the final trimester of the school year. Thirty-four percent received second honors, and nineteen percent received third honors. Eighteen students received first honors throughout the entire school year.

Saint Joseph School uses a rigorous grading scale, rather than a 10 percentage point increment scale: 93-100% is an A, 85-92% is a B, and 76-84% is a C.

Students who receive honors are given a blue, red, or white ribbon for their 1st, 2nd, or 3rd honors, respectively, each trimester. Any student who receives 1st honors all year earns a trophy. Students are recognized and rewarded during a school Mass.
