Miami Heights man awarded K of C Sir Knight of the Year

A local Knights of Columbus leader was named the Fr. Hennepin Province Fourth Degree Sir Knight of the Year at the recent Provincial Meeting held in Sterling Heights, Michigan the weekend of October 2-4, 2009. Sir Knight Charles S. Wilke, a Past Faithful Navigator of Most Holy Rosary Assembly based in Harrison, Ohio received the award for his work with the Patriotic branch of the order. The Hennepin Province is made up of all Fourth Degree Assemblies in both Michigan and Ohio. The award was presented during the Saturday evening banquet which was attended by over 300 knights and guests. Provincial Vice Supreme Master George Mallison presented the plaque to Sir Knight Wilke, which was engraved with "for outstanding contribution to church, country, and the Knights of Columbus". Only about 17% of all K of C members achieve the honor of Fourth Degree, the highest rank in the group.
