CONDUCT CODE

In addition to modest dress modesty in speech and actions are required. Clothing in class should not create a distraction (no underwear or belly showing). Disruption in class will not be tolerated. Parents will be notified of any behavior problems.

GUIDELINES FOR RELIGIOUS EDUCATION CLASSES:

- ✓ Show up on time and be in your seat when class begins.
- ✓ Be polite and show respect for the feelings of all students and adults.
- ✓ Be a good listener, no side conversations or interruptions when anyone is speaking.
- ✓ **Cell phones must be turned off and placed in the basket in the classroom.**
- ✓ Please raise your hand if you wish to speak.
- ✓ Respect everyone's opinions as you'd want them to respect yours.
- ✓ Follow teacher's directions immediately.
- ✓ Be an interested achiever, be responsible, do assignments immediately.
- ✓ Come prepared to participate.
- ✓ Respect your own and other's property and person.

Failure to display proper classroom behavior after 2 verbal warnings will lead to:

1. A call to parents. The student will be picked up or sent home. A written notice will be given or sent to parents.
2. Entrance back into class will be allowed only upon completion of assigned material to the satisfaction of the catechist; plus a written note of apology to the teacher.
3. Parent may be asked to accompany student to the next class and any other classes if the catechist or DRE thinks it is necessary.

Dismissal from class after 2 verbal warnings will be tolerated only once. Another offense will require a conference with Fr. Matzek, student, and parent/s. Further, the student will only be allowed to attend Youth Events accompanied by a parent chaperone.

Winter Bad Weather Policy

- If Prescott Public Schools cancel classes or calls for early release due to bad weather, CCD classes at St. Mary's will automatically be cancelled.
- If a winter storm warning is announced, classes will automatically be cancelled.
- If weather turns bad later in the day requiring CCD classes to be cancelled, an attempt will be made to telephone the student's home with that information.
