

Guidelines for entering PreK at St. Mary School

1. Must have turned 3 by April 1st prior to school year.
2. Must be completely toilet trained
 - a. no pull-ups
 - b. able to unzip/zip and unbutton/button pants
 - c. able to get on and off full size toilet and wipe self
3. Must be able to wash hands, blow own nose, etc.
4. Must be current on immunizations (office must have one on file)
5. Must have a physical and eye exam upon entering school (also need copies on file in the office)
6. Must have turned 3 by April 1st prior to school year.
7. Must be completely toilet trained
 - d. no pull-ups
 - e. able to unzip/zip and unbutton/button pants
 - f. able to get on and off full size toilet and wipe self
8. Must be able to wash hands, blow own nose, etc.
9. Must be current on immunizations (office must have one on file)
10. Must have a physical and eye exam upon entering school (also need copies on file in the office)

Three-year-olds will attend the PreK program for two years before entering kindergarten. All students (3 & 4 yr. olds) will do the same work with expectations slightly higher for the 4-year-olds.

Note: St. Mary's PreK program focuses on preparing children for kindergarten academically as well as socially.
